Thank you to Heather and Dallas for organising a lot of things behind the scenes and keeping everyone up to date. The Scout Hall has been a great venue to meet and as I will not be renominating my position as President, I thank you all.

Special thanks to Les for being prepared to undertake the signing of our permits; we wish Les all the best in his recovery.

After considerable discussion, the motion was seconded by Vince Thorne. Carried.

All other memberships paid between 1st June to 30th June, 2019 will be required to pay \$50.00 per annum for members who receive their Newsletter via email or \$55.00 per year for members who opt to receive their Newsletter via mail. All memberships not paid by 30th June, 2019 will be deemed to have lapsed membership.

- Colac Collectable Car Club members are asked to ensure that details of all vehicles and motorcycles are correct as it is imperative that the Clubs records and the records of Vic Roads are identical.
- Following a request from the 3rd 4th Colac Scout Group for assistance with the funding of a
 cooler/heater for their Hall it was moved by George Tolley, seconded Len Forster that \$2,000 be
 donated to the Scout Group to help with the purchase of a much-needed heater/cooler for the hall.
 Motion carried.

 Discussion re clarification of commercial vehicles and the Club Permit Scheme permitted vehicles. As stated in the AOMC News, May, 2018:-

"Reporting a Club Permit Scheme Vehicle – if you see a vehicle that either:-

- a. Should not be on the Victorian Club Permit Scheme;
- b. Has a "H" plate when it should have an "M" plate;
- c. Is operating outside the terms of the permit (eg. Number of days, used for commercial gain etc)

Then send:

- (i) A photo of the vehicle. The time, date and location that the photo was taken;
- (ii) The reason you believe an offence has occurred
- (iii) Your name, address and phone number

To: AOMC, 21 Rosalie Street, Springvale. 3171 – email: secretary@aomc.asn.au The AOMC will check that the information provided is complete and correct and will pass it on to Vic Roads. Note that the AOMC will not pass on your details (unless asked by Vic Roads) and then only with your permission. The AOMC cannot guarantee that we can report back on the outcome of your notification."

RENEWING YOUR CLUB PERMIT WITH NO CHANGES

Once you have received your renewal for your Club Permit in the mail and you do not wish to change your period of days, you must:

- 1. Provide your Club with the Club Permit Renewal for your vehicle. The renewal must then be signed by an authorised officer of the Club to declare that you are a current financial member of that particular Club. Authorised officers include: Club President, Secretary, or Treasurer, Permit Scheme Officer.
- 2. The Club Permit renewal must then be signed by the club permit holder.
- 3. Attend any VicRoads Customer Service Centre to pay the renewal fee, or mail renewal to VicRoads with a cheque or money order to:

VicRoads, GPO Box 1644, Melbourne, VIC 3001.
